Training Requirements for Aggression Replacement Training® (ART)

The following are the training requirements for the ART® program:

- Initial three (3) day facilitator training with Master Trainer/Consultant Mark Amendola, or his designated ART® Trainer
 - > Includes one (1) year of Fidelity Management
 - Travel costs (mileage, lodging, meals) for the Master Trainer are <u>not</u> included and should be budgeted out separately.)
- One (1) day Booster Training
- Agency Trainer (TOT) training/process
 - It is recommended that your organization budget for 1-2 Agency Trainers to address attrition and sustainability of the ART program.
- Support/Fidelity Monitoring These costs are included in the initial facilitator training. However, you must budget separately if your agency's facilitators are trained through other means (i.e. attends another agency's training.)
 - > Includes check-in calls and visits for the first year of implementation
 - On-site observations of sessions
 - > Review of video tapes, moving toward facilitator proficiency rating
- Fidelity Verification Visit
 - This visit occurs in Year 2 of your grant. The visit will be on-site and include a letter and recommendations to PCCD regarding quality of program implementation.
