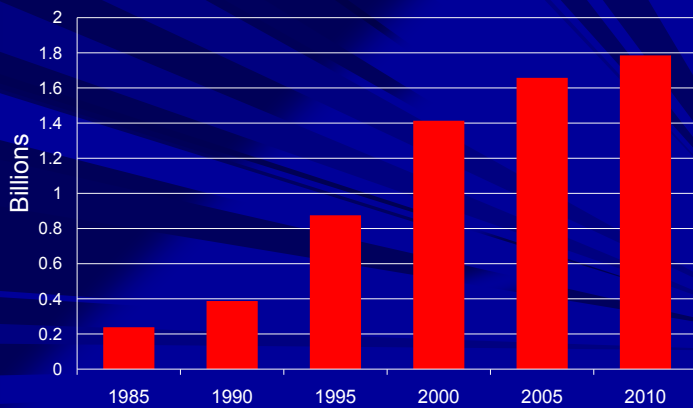

HISTORY OF PREVENTION FUNDING

— Pennsylvania's Investment in Proven Effective Practices Continues to Decline —

History of State Funding for Corrections



- Pennsylvania's prison spending has increased by nearly **650%** since 1985.
- In the proposed 2010-11 budget, while nearly every other budget category is being cut prison spending is proposed to increase, yet again, by nearly **\$145 Million**.
- While workers in nearly every job sector have gone 2 years or more without even basic cost-of-living increases, state prison guards have gotten nearly **11% salary increases** in the last 18 months.

The operating cost of the Department of Corrections is **\$4.9 Million PER DAY!**
 The proposed funding level for evidence-based prevention programs in the 2010-11 state budget is a mere **\$3,287 PER DAY!**

Funding for proven-effective prevention programs has been reduced by **93%** since 2002.



The total state budget for evidence-based prevention is **\$3.2 Million** and is facing another **67% cut** which would reduce the amount to **< \$1 Million**.
